# Definition of California Indian Tribe AB 275 (Ramos)

- Cal. H&S Code 8012(c)(1)(2)
- Federally recognized tribes
- On the contact list maintained by the NAHC for the purposes of consultation pursuant to Section 65352.3 of the California Government Code
- January 1, 2021 deadline for contact list
- When completed the NAHC must notify state agencies, state-funded museums and tribes in writing

# NAHC Role

- **Commission Assistance to Agencies and Museums Concerning Cultural Affiliation**
  - Updating of Inventories and Summaries
  - Consultation points
- **Commission Notice of Preliminary Inventories and Assistance with Identifying Tribes**
  - Notices
- **Tribal Review During the 30-day Website Review Period**
  - Tribes may concur or disagree
- **Setting Inventory Status as Final**
  - Concurrence, Disagreement or Nonresponse
  - Status may be changed

# NAHC Role

- **Claims Process**

- Filed with the NAHC and forwarded to Agencies and Museums by NAHC
- Publish request on website

- **Repatriation Agreements**

- **Disputes & Mediation**

- By June 30, 2021 Commission must adopt mediation procedures
- Notification of dispute to parties
- Documentation Exchange
- If dispute cannot be resolved through mediation Commission resolves dispute
- Commission decision is a final administrative remedy
